For the past 40 years there has been a mortgage on the property of our church. One of our goals in 2020 was to pay off the church mortgage. We were planning to have a fundraiser called "Burn the Mortgage, Not the Burgers" and then the pandemic hit. The Montessori School closed, renters left and weddings were postponed. We called Farmers and Merchants Bank and asked if we could delay our mortgage payments for three months. They kindly granted our request. People in our congregation stepped up with sacrificial giving. On March 25th I received a congratulatory letter from Peter Meyers, First Vice President of Farmers and Merchants Bank that our mortgage was paid off and our property is free and clear (see letter on page 7). I want to thank all of you for your contributions and for making this goal a reality.

Come and join us on Easter Sunday as we celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord, burn the mortgage, and eat burgers outside. I want to also thank Eleanor Phillips for inventing the game "9". People responded by giving amounts of 99 cents to \$999.99 to eliminate our mortgage. Eleanor would like to share these words of thanks with the church: "Thank you to our Father in heaven, to those that have paid on the mortgage and to those that have played NINE. It came from your heart, and now I want to thank you from the bottom of my heart. We will now be able to give more."

During the barbeque following Easter worship we will celebrate Eleanor's 99th birthday! We will social distance and eat together under the trees. 

Missions' Corner: A Newsletter from Mission Ministries Philippines

DEEP WELL PROJECT AT EASTGATE FRUITFUL LIFE LEARNING CENTER

"Dreams become REALITY when we put our MIND to it."

t was early 2020 when one of Mission Ministries Philippines' (MMP) friends, Bro. Michael "Mike" Villareal from First Congregational Church of Anaheim (California, USA) and the MMP team visited one of our partners, Eastgate Fruitful Life Learning Center in Brgy. Macabud, Rodriguez, Rizal. The purpose of the visit is for Bro. Mike and the team to have a concrete preschool exposure, to see the learning development of the children, and to meet the teachers. During the visit, Pastor Rodel Alcantara, the school administrator and head pastor of Eastgate Fruitful Life Community Church, shared his vision and dreams of his church and learning center. He also shared the current condition of the community where he is serving. The families living there have limited access of water for drinking and other household use. The community has only one (1) deep well to cater hundreds of families. Pastor Rodel, along with some of his church members, uses his tricycle to transport all their water containers to the deep well area and have it refilled. It usually takes them several hours to be served due to the long line. Pastor Rodel has been in the community serving God for fourteen (14) years. Upon seeing the plight in the community, Bro. Mike's heart was greatly moved. He then shared his visitation experience to his congregation, addressing the needs of the community. By the grace of God, He used the leaders and members of the First Congregational Church of Anaheim to install deep well to the said partner learning center and church.

The installation of deep well project started last February 1, 2021, and after one (1) month, the deep well is completely finished and fully operational. The DREAM of Pastor Rodel became a REALITY because of faithful donors and prayer warriors like you.

Knowing Mission Ministries Phillipines

Mission Ministries Philippines is an institution established in 1984 to help churches, different groups and individuals to develop a spiritual, educational, social, and economic ministry among impoverished communities.

One of its methodologies to mobilize communities/churches is to develop an Early Childhood Education Program for indigent children where they assist the organizers by providing the curriculum, workbooks for children, and other materials following a Progressive Philosophy of Education.

MMP provides seminars and workshops for teachers, administrators, parents, and staff to better equip its partners in managing and sustaining a Developmentally Appropriate Early Childhood Education. Their vision is, All preschool children in vulnerable communities have access to quality education.

To date, MMP has established more than 1,000 Preschools/Day Care Centers catering to urban poor communities, mostly in partnership with churches.
