

#### **Rooted Groups Starting this Fall!**

Pastor Jim often says, "I believe small groups are where it's at." There is so much truth in that statement. Small groups offer us space to connect with others and encourage us to go deeper in our faith. The Holy Spirit has an amazing way of showing up in conversation when people are willing to honestly and humbly share their lives, their questions and their faith with one another.

This fall we are excited to facilitate Rooted groups. Rooted is a small group experience that was designed by Mariners Church. The church was discouraged to find that Christians are just as likely to embrace lifestyles that are consumer-driven, self-centered and immoral as those who do not claim to be Christ followers. They found that Christians in the Western world tend to know information, but they do not necessarily experience the transformation promised in Scriptures. Mariners was led to explore how they might encourage transformation in Christ. Below is an excerpt written by Mariners Church:

"We at Mariners wanted to create an experience that bridged the disparity between what we say we believe, and how we live. We wanted something that would be experiential and transferable across all ages, stages and even cultures.

"In 2008, Mariners began a partnership with Pastor Muriithi Wanjau and Mavuno Church in Nairobi, Kenya and we quickly learned they had a similar passion to see people encounter God and grow deeper in their relationship with Him and His Church...During one of our visits to Mavuno, they told us about an experience their church family was going through that had been developed by Pastor Muriithi. They called it Mizizi, Swahili for 'roots.' It wasn't a Bible study, class, or program, and it wasn't 'taught' in the traditional sense. It was a 10-week journey with daily homework that each member of their church went on in the community with each other. Groups of men and women would gather each week, and through a study guide and a facilitator, walk through Scripture, and discover God's purpose for them in their church family and the world.

"The impact of Mizizi on their church was staggering. Thousands of people were discovering for the first time that God loved them specifically and had a beautiful plan for their lives. (Continued on Page 7)

### A Door Opens for a Moment

"I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My word, and have not denied My name." Rev. 3.8



#### Dearest Friends,

Yes, we are in Bethlehem! It is by God's grace and your prayers. A colleague who helped obtain government permission for us to enter Israel wrote today: "You can't imagine how close you came to being refused entry. Another couple who received permission the same day as you but was flying a week later is required to go to a consulate to get the visa stickers in their passports. The problem is, there are no appointments available, or the consulate does not respond to requests. So, they are stuck."

Israel's closure due to the pandemic has been tough on tourist-dependent Bethlehem. Hotels are closed, olive wood souvenir shops are selling vegetables, and there are no foreigners in sight. The first taxi driver who picked us up said, "I can't believe you are here! You are the first foreigners I have seen in months!"

Jack Sara, president, and everyone at Bethlehem Bible College has received us so warmly. We have an apartment right on campus. From the moment of our arrival, it has been clear that people are starved for fellowship. We already have made new friends.

At the college, we are developing a peace and reconciliation program based on the teachings of Jesus that serves both the Palestinian and international communities. One of our goals is to promote the reasonableness of peacemaking, as opposed to the assumption that violence is necessary in a broken world.

...Thank you again for your persistence in prayer over many months that helped us finally arrive in Jerusalem and Bethlehem. We appreciate your prayers as we pull together what we need to begin our work here. A used compact car is at the top of the list, which we will need to travel into Jerusalem to lead the East Jerusalem International Church. *God bless you all!*

"They learned God has gifted each of them perfectly for His purposes. They learned how to pray and how to unleash the power of His Spirit. They learned about Jesus' heart for serving the poor, His ability to destroy Satan's strongholds in their lives, and how He wants them to steward the material resources He's given them...Mavuno could hardly keep up with the growth of Mizizi because family members and co-workers who didn't go to church or have a relationship with Jesus were signing up in droves. They saw their friends and family members' lives change before their eyes, and they wanted to know why and how it was happening. The Good News was proving to be really good news when tested. It was astounding to witness.

"We wondered what God might do if we brought Mizizi to Orange County.

"We began to work with Pastor Muriithi to adapt the Mizizi experience to our culture while keeping the spirit of the original work. We prayed God would use it in the lives of our staff and church family, and He honored our prayers. As people moved through this experience, it became clear it wasn't the curriculum that was changing lives; it was God. People came with open hearts, expectant of what God would show them. And, He did not disappoint..."

We are excited to offer Rooted groups this fall at FCCA. The Rooted experience encourages 7 rhythms in our faith journey: daily devotion, prayer, freedom from strongholds, sacrificial generosity, serve the community, share your story and celebration. The goal of Rooted is for you to deepen your connection with God, His Church and with your purpose. Part of the Rooted experience is also to share our faith journeys with one another. It is a space to listen without judgment, share authentically and pray together for the Holy Spirit to be at work. We will not attempt to "fix" one another.

Rooted groups will start the week of September 5th and will go through the week of November 7th (10 weeks). We are planning for Tuesday evenings at 6:30pm, Wednesday evenings at 7pm and possibly an additional daytime option on a weekday. If you plan to participate, we hope that you make a commitment to attend all group meetings—each person adds an important dynamic to the group! If you know you would miss more than two group meetings, we ask that you attend a different small group session. We are so excited to see how God will be at work during our time together!
