



The Panamerican Institute is a school in Tijuana that was begun by a Congregational pastor and is now run by individuals from Tijuana, many of whom graduated from the school themselves. The school provides quality education for students that are equivalent to middle school age in the U.S. Students are from low-income families, and the school not only educates the students but feeds them on school days.
