

One of the encouraging new ministries here is **MomCo**, an opportunity for moms to build community and tackle motherhood together. MomCo provides a welcoming place where women can be honest, supported, and strengthened as they navigate the many joys and challenges of raising children. Conversations and gatherings center on real-life topics such as parenting, relationships, finances, and spiritual growth.

This past year has also been a tender one for our **JOG – Just Ordinary Guys** ministry. In 2025, the group lost several key men. We continue to grieve their passing, give thanks for their legacy, and honor the way they lived out their faith. At the same time, God is doing something new. In recent months, new men have stepped forward into leadership roles. They are bringing fresh energy and a desire to serve. JOG continues to be a place where men grow in Christ and support one another.

Adding to this season of renewal, our church is privileged to hear the upcoming testimony of **guest speaker Astronaut Guy Gardner**. His life story is remarkable: a fighter pilot who flew 177 combat missions in Vietnam, an astronaut who flew on two space shuttle missions, later he was a teacher, an advocate for underprivileged youth, and college president. Guy Gardner's story is one of perseverance, humility, and a sincere commitment to honor God in every chapter of life. From the cockpit to the classroom to outer space, his journey reflects a faith lived out daily.

Scripture tells us that God is always making things new. New studies, new ministries, new leaders, renewed hearts, and fresh vision are signs that the Spirit is active among us. We are grateful for what God has done and are excited about what He is doing. May we continue to open our hearts to His work and step forward together into the new things God is unfolding in our church family.

*Your support for the beleaguered Christians in Gaza is so encouraging. The Christians that remain in Gaza – about 400 – either have no route to leave or have decided to stay regardless of their fate. There has been a Christian community in Gaza since the first century. As a result of your generosity, we have sent about \$12,000 in relief through Bethlehem Bible College. Wow! Thank you! We will follow up with further reports on the Gaza Christians.*



**Shireen Awwad Hilal** (pictured) leads the college's relief program called *The Shepherd's Society*. She has extended Christian family members living in Gaza. In 2024, a missile struck the church in which her family was sheltering, killing her aunt and others.

*Shireen embodies the Palestinian trait of sumud, resilience. Her faith has not been shaken. "We thank God for your support for the Christians in Gaza who remain. Food is scarce and expensive, as are medications and water. Your support is a lifeline to these precious sisters and brothers of all ages."*

*Karen and I are grateful as we consider all the promise of this new year. Karen and I will travel to Bethlehem in the spring to lead a peacemaking program. Also, we continue to lead the Hebron Road International Church (online).*



### **Meet Guy Gardner, Astronaut**



Guy Gardner’s life reflects courage, discipline, and a deep sense of purpose. Raised in Altavista, Virginia, he pursued a lifelong dream of flight, becoming an Air Force fighter and test pilot who flew 177 combat missions in Vietnam before being selected as a NASA astronaut. Guy piloted two Space Shuttle missions and later held key leadership roles, including directing the Shuttle-Mir program and serving in aviation safety for the FAA. Throughout his career, he has been known as a steady leader, mentor, and servant to others.

After his government service, Guy devoted himself to education, serving as a teacher, school leader, and college president. He and his wife Linda have been married for over 50 years and raised three children, and he remains actively involved in church and community life as a Sunday school teacher, youth leader, and speaker. Guy’s story is one of faith lived out through perseverance, humility, and a commitment to honoring God in every season of life.
