THESSALONIKI, GREECE GRAND HOTEL PALACE, THESSALONIKI, GREECE MAY 22-26, 2025

Last May, my brother, sister and I traveled to Greece. It was an incredible trip! We spent a number of days with our friend Pantelis Sidiropoulos who showed us in and around the ancient city of Thessaloniki which is the second largest city in Greece. It is known for its natural beauty, views of the sea and youthful atmosphere. Over 100,000 university students reside in the city which is vibrant with life. We were so impressed with the archaeological sites, museums and with the genuine hospitality shown to us by members at the churches we visited.

Evangelical Church. He ministered for fifteen years with Agape Greece, (CRU) "Family Life Ministry" and continues to be involved with Macedonian Outreach, a ministry to the Balkan Countries.

Now, as a retired grandfather, of six grandchildren, he participates with Legacy Coalition, an international Christian Movement, to assist and train grandparents to be more effective in their role in "Intentional Grandparenting." In July 2023, he and his wife, Roula, celebrated fifty years of marriage.



We're putting the finishing touches on our next home. Here's a sneak peek:


These homes are more than just buildings. They are <u>SANCTUARIES</u>.

An Excerpt from Andrew and Karen Bush's Latest Newsletter

Dearest Friends

Greetings! We pray God is blessing you every day!

In the Middle East... Life in the West Bank is increasingly difficult. The roads between cities in the north are becoming unsafe to travel. One of our Palestinian Christian friends recently tried to visit friends in Ramallah, north of Jerusalem. She and her family were shocked to be stopped on the highway at gunpoint en route back to Bethlehem. They were permitted to eventually move on and arrive home, but their children were terrified by the encounter. They've decided to stay within the confines of Bethlehem. The Palestinian Christian community is deeply concerned because the

violence on the West Bank is looking more and more like that in Gaza. The beautiful Makhrur Valley west of Bethlehem is a route hikers enjoy, such as this group we led in May. (That's Karen with the blue backpack!) This month I would think twice before hiking along its ancient aqueducts. Plans for a new Israeli settlement in the valley have spiked tensions in the area.

An important thought... Recently I shared in a church in the US about the humanizing power of the cross of Christ. I noted that what enables people to take human life so easily is the prior dehumanization of the victims. On the cross Jesus identified with – and thus highly valued – humanity in its frailty,



brokenness and marginalization. To be crucified with Christ is to value and serve others. Serving the "other" is a powerful antidote to dehumanizing them. (Philippians 2.5-8)
