"What a Great Day!"

Last Wednesday, I felt so blessed to be a part of our church family! In the morning Pastor Emily and I had a Zoom call with the International Congregational Fellowship Program Committee. It was so good to receive input from members in other places. Through the wonders of technology we spoke with Pantelis Sideropoulos from Greece who offered some good ideas for our upcoming International Congregational Fellowship meeting in Fiji. Six of us from our church along with Simon Gounder (the founder of Global AIM) will join other Congregationalists for this meeting. We are looking forward to this time together!

Following the Zoom call, there were phone calls to return, emails to respond to, facility decisions to be made, and an Encouragement for Today Devotional to create. Later I met my good friend Mark Ayres for lunch. Mark and I had the joy of leading pastors' conferences in the Marshall Islands and in Myanmar (Burma) in years past. Next week Mark and his wife Debbie are returning as missionaries to Malaysia. Mark mentioned to me that Pastor Maa was attending a conference in Anaheim and he and Debbie were meeting her for dinner. He invited me to join them. It was an inspiring time. Pastor Maa was the superintendent of many churches in Myanmar. She graciously hosted Mark and me when we led a pastors' conference in Myanmar shortly before the pandemic. Unfortunately, Pastor Maa contacted COVID and was hospitalized for many months. She was in desperate need of oxygen which was very expensive because it was in short supply. When we heard about her need, our church responded by sending her a generous gift to help cover the expense. After many months of fighting COVID Pastor Maa was pronounced dead by the attending physician. Her sister and others continued to pray as people wept over her body. After 45 minutes Pastor Maa stirred. (Continued on Page 7)



The medical staff were shocked - she was alive! We don't know if she was in a deep coma state and they could not detect her heart beat or if she had died. In either case we are so grateful she is alive and doing well. As we dined together last Wednesday she shared that when the doctors pronounced her dead, she felt an incredible peace and deep joy. It was an amazing experience and she didn't want to come back to the life she knew before. Pastor Maa mentioned that words seemed so limited in describing her "out of body" experience. Mark, Debbie and I were filled with awe as she shared her experience with us.

After dinner I attended the Bible Study on "Job." What a great time we had together! Honest conversations filled with laughter and a few tears made for a memorable time. While walking around our church campus following the Bible Study, it was nice to hear singing in various languages as people worshiped the Lord. As I reflected on the day while driving home that evening I thought what a privilege it is to be a part of our church family!
